Credit system = 70 credits possible each year

- 1 credit for each week = 36
- 5 credits for S.T.R.I.V.E. participation
- 5 credits for church camp/mission trip participation
- 5 credits for St. Mark's 101 (confirmation) participation
- 3 credits for student minstry retreat or Chrysalis
- 3 credits for volunteering for St. Mark's VBS or Sports camp
- 2 credits for finding hole sponsors and golf teams for student ministry golf tournament in the Spring

Minimum yearly grad requirements = 35 credits

- *student must also participate in S.T.R.I.V.E. work day and reach at least the 1st level (\$150) of the fundraiser.
- *student must also be present at the end of the year J.U. Banquet
- *at least 22 of the 35 credits must come from Sunday school attendance

Honor grad yearly requirements = at least 48 credits

- *student must participate in S.T.R.I.V.E. work day and reach at least the 3rd level (\$650) of the fundraiser
- *student must also be present at the end of the year J.U. Banquet
- *at least 30 of the 48 credits must come from Sunday school attendance
- *top three students who have fulfilled requirements will be awarded honor grad status at the J.U. Banquet and will receive an additional \$50 in their scholarfund account.
